





Table Mountain and Victoria and Alfred (V&A) Waterfront, Western Cape

In December 2012, Table Mountain was officially inaugurated as a New7 Wonder of Nature. Table Mountain has withstood six million years of erosion and hosts the richest, yet smallest floral kingdom on Earth with over 1 470 floral species. The mountain boasts numerous rare and endangered species. It is the most recognised site in Cape Town, owing to its unique flat-topped peaks which reach 1 086 m above sea level. It forms part of the Table Mountain National Park – one of 21 parks managed by South African National Parks.

The V&A Waterfront attracts millions of visitors every year due to the location's combination of shops, restaurants, nightspots, tourist attractions and museums.
