The African energy market opportunity

- Over US\$200–240 billion per year in energy investment is required by 2030 to meet Africa's growing electricity demand, achieve universal energy access and deliver the continent's energy transition.
- This equates to well over US\$1.5 trillion of cumulative investment opportunities between now and 2030 across generation, transmission, distribution, storage, clean cooking, gas infrastructure, hydrogen, nuclear and digital energy technologies.
- Today, Africa attracts only around 3% of global energy investment, despite accounting for almost 20% of the world's population, highlighting the significant untapped growth potential.
- Around 600 million Africans still lack access to electricity, while approximately 1 billion people lack access to clean cooking, creating one of the world's largest infrastructure investment opportunities.
- Electricity investment alone is expected to increase from less than US\$30 billion per year to more than US\$120 billion annually by 2030, with around half directed towards renewable energy generation and the balance towards grids, transmission, storage and other infrastructure.
