#### VISA EXEMPTION FOR HOLDERS OF ORDINARY PASSPORTS OF HUNGARY, SLOVENIA, ROMANIA, LATVIA, ESTONIA AND CROATIA

On 27 August 2025, Dr L A Schreiber, MP, Minister of Home Affairs exercised the discretion bestowed upon him in section 10A(4)(a) of the Immigration Act, 2002 (Act No. 10 of 2002) and exempted ordinary passport holders of Hungary, Slovenia, Romania, Latvia, Estonia and Croatia from the requirement to be in possession of port of entry visas for a period not exceeding 90 days per visit.

#### IMMIGRATION CIRCULAR NO 14 OF 2025: EXTENSION OF EXEMPTION OF VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR HOLDERS OF ORDINARY PASSPORTS OF HUNGARY

- The purpose of this circular is to inform all officials that the Minister of Home Affairs has, with immediate effect, 1. decided to extend the period of the exemption that ordinary passport holders of Hungary enjoy from the requirement to be in possession of a port of entry visa, to a period not exceeding ninety (90) days per visit.
- This visa exemption is applicable to visits other than those for which a visa for temporary sojourn as 2. contemplated in sections 13 to 24 of the Immigration Act, 2002 (Act No. 13 of 2002) is required.
- The visa exemption enters into force with immediate effect. 3.
- The contents of this Immigration Directive must be brought to the attention of all immigration officers and 4. consular officials.
