BALI, INDONESIA TOURIST LEVY

The Embassy of the Republic of South Africa in Indonesia wishes to inform that as from 14 February 2024 the Bali Provincial Government will implement a tourist levy of Rp. 150,000.00 (one hundred and fifty thousand Indonesian Rupiah)/ ZAR 200.00 per person for every foreign tourist visiting Bali.

This initiative is undertaken to improve service quality, protect the local culture, and the natural environment in Bali.

The benefits that will be achieved from the international tourist levy are as follows:

1. Natural environment that is cleaner, beautiful, comprehensively everlasting and sustainable.
2. Cleanliness, orderliness, convenience, and safety in Bali;
3. The infrastructure and facilities of public transportation with good quality
4. And other things, such as custom management, traditions, art cultured, well-managed local wisdom with spiritual aura (metaksu).
