

WHO NEEDS TO NOTIFY THE IEC TO VOTE ABROAD – AFTER VOTER REGISTRATION HAS CLOSED?





NOTIFICATION (VEC10) PERIOD GUIDELINES



- To vote abroad, a person must
 - ☐ Be a RSA citizen
 - ☐ Be registered to vote either at a mission abroad or in South Africa
 - ☐ Need their RSA identity card/document. A RSA passport is NOT needed to vote abroad.
 - ☐ If a registered voter intends to vote at the mission where registered: NO NEED to submit an online VEC10 form. The voter's detail will already appear on that specific embassy's voting list.
 - ☐ If a voter is **not registered** at the mission where they intend to vote, then the voter needs to complete an **online VEC10 form** to notify the IEC and at which mission voter intends to vote
- When may registered voters notify the IEC? 23 Feb 2024 to 22 April 2024
- How to notify the IEC? Complete the online VEC10 form available on IEC's website www.elections.org.za
- REMEMBER DIRCO staff not registered at the embassy where they intend to vote, must also complete online VEC10 form within this period



ROLE OF STAFF DURING NOTIFICATION PERIOD

STAFF ROLE WHEN PERSON VISITS THE EMBASSY during the VEC10 notification period (23 Feb - 22 April)


- 1. Assist voter by checking voter registration details on IEC's website www.elections.org.za
 - If voter is not registered at the mission, and the voter intends to vote at the mission, the voter should complete an online VEC10 form
 - If voter is registered at the mission but intends to vote at a different mission as where registered, voter to complete an online VEC10 form
- 2. If a voter needs to submit an online VEC10 form, please assist voter if required. The online VEC10 form is available on IEC's website www.elections.org.za
- 3. Online system closes at midnight SA time on 22 April as specified in election timetable
- 4. This is an online notification process only
- 5. Voters to be notified of notification status via e-mail/sms
