LIFE PARTNER VISA

A life partner visa can be issued for a period of up to three (3) years and the holder of this visa can conduct work. The application shall be accompanied by:

- Machine readable valid passport with at least two blank pages and valid for no less than 30 days after the intended duration of stay in South Africa
- Two passport size photos
- Duly completed DHA-1738 Visa Application Form (complete with black pen)
- Certified copy of the bio page of the applicant's passport
- Application fee of US\$36.00 (cash or bank cheque)
- Yellow fever vaccination certificate if the applicant travelled or intends travelling from or transiting through a yellow fever endemic area
- Proof of cohabitation for a minimum of two (2) years, eg shared lease agreement,
 utility bills or official letters showing a shared address
- Notarial life partner contract/agreement to confirm good faith relationship and permanence of your partnership
- Proof of financial stability, ie provide evidence of financial support, showing a
 minimum income of R8 500 per month in the form of a bank statement or monthly
 salary slips and how the financial responsibilities are shared by the parties
- Support letter and certified copy of ID of spouse who is a South African citizen or PR holder
- Divorce decree, where applicable
- Police clearance certificate in respect of applicants 18 years and older for all countries where an applicant has resided for a continuous period of one year or longer for the past five (5) years
- Employment Offer (if applicable): If applying for a work endorsement, submit a
 job offer
- Business Registration (if applicable): If applying for a business endorsement,
 provide proof of business registration.

- Study Acceptance (if applicable): If applying for a study endorsement, submit proof of acceptance into an educational institution
- Medical report
- Medical insurance valid for at least twelve (12) months and renewable for the remainder of the stay in South Africa
- Flight reservation
