#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Question 1. How to deposit visa and other consular fees to SBM Bank?

Answer. Details for visa fee payment:

- ✓ Provide account details, namely, the account name and the account number.
- ✓ Applicant/ Customer can make deposit at any SBM branch during office hours. SBM (Antsahavola, Andraharo, Behoririka, Tanjombato and Tamatave)
- ✓ Insert customer name as: SOUTH AFRICAN EMBASSY
- ✓ Account no. of the Embassy: MGA ACCOUNT NO: 90130200011121
- ✓ Applicant to write his/her **FULL NAME** as per PASSPORT and the phone number.

NB: All charges (both sending and receiving banks) relating to the payment made by bank transfer are for the applicant's account.

NB: for groups please make one payment / transfer.

# Question 2. How can I apply for a visa or any consular services?

Answer. Apply directly from the South African Embassy in Ankorondrano or you can obtain visa

requirements from the website: http://www.dirco.gov.za/madagascar/

#### Question 3. How much is the visa fees?

Answer. Normal Visitors Visa/Permit = MGA 104 000

### Question 4. Do I need a yellow fever vaccination card when travelling to South Africa?

Answer. Yes, you need a yellow fever vaccination card before travelling to South Africa.

# Question 5. Parental Consent Affidavit will be required when travelling with minor children

Answer. Please find the form on the website or visit the South African Embassy

### Question 6. How long does it take to issue a visa?

Answer. It take 5 working days to process the visa, in exceptional cases like medical or death it

can be issued before hand

#### Question 7. On tourism visa how much funds must an applicant have?

Answer. It all depend on the period but we are looking at R2000.00 per week without

accommodation.

### Question 8. How to apply for a study permit?

Answer: Apply directly from the South African Embassy in Ankorondrano or you can obtain

Please take note for any permit the time period to process is 4 weeks and not 5 working days.

## Question 9. What services do the Embassy render?

Answer. Civic services for South Africans living in Madagascar e.g. ID documents, Passports,

Birth / Death and Marriage Certificates. Immigration Services e.g. Visas and Permits to

any nationality living in Madagascar that have residence in Madagascar.
