

CinemAfrica Film Festival 18 - 25 October 2006

Now it is high time for the CinemAfrica Film Festival! On its 10th anniversary, CinemAfrica will host movies from 16 different African countries.

The festival opens on 18 October with the critically acclaimed feature film Drum. Zola Maseko, director and a new star on the South African scene, will present his film about a couple of journalists at the legendary magazine Drum back in the 1950s, and the equally legendary township of Sophiatown in Johannesburg.

Other films screened include the music documentary Mahaleo from Madagascar, the feature Wrestling Grounds about Senegalese wrestling, urban comedy from Burkina Faso and road movies from South Africa and Morocco. A special section of the festival will focus on film from East Africa.

The CinemAfrica Film Festival takes place in Stockholm on 18 - 25 October at the Zita cinema and Moderna Museet.
