A persons who wish to retire in South Africa may apply for a retired person visa, provided that he or she receives at least R37 000 per month from a pension fund or an irrevocable retirement annuity or has a net worth or a combination of assets realising a minimum monthly income of R37 000.

2	Valid passport which expires in no less than 30 days after expiry of the intended date of departure from the Republic in terms of regulation 9(1)(a)			
3	Original Police clearance certificate issued by the police or security authority in each country where the relevant applicant resided for 12 months or longer after attaining the age of 18 years except for South Africa, in respect of criminal records or the character of that applicant, which certificate shall not be older than six months at the time of its submission. (Provided that the certificate shall not be required from a foreign country in the case of renewal or extension of a visa)			
4	The application is being submitted in person, no less than 60 days prior to the expiry date of the applicant's visa and if the visa was issued for less than 30 days, not later than seven working days before the expiry of the visa.			
5	A medical report not older than 6 months			
6	A radiological report.			
7	Marriage certificate or in the case of a foreign spousal relationship, proof of official recognition thereof issued by the authorities of the foreign country of the applicant (where applicable).			
8	The affidavit where a spousal relationship to a South African citizen or resident is applicable, as well as documentation proving cohabitation and the extent to which the related financial responsibilities are shared by the parties and setting out the particulars of children in the spousal relationship.			

9	Divorce decree, where applicable.		
10	Court order granting full or specific parental responsibilities and rights, where applicable.		
11	Death certificate, in respect of late spouse, where applicable.		
12	Written consent from both parents and full parental responsibilities, where applicable.		
13	Divorce decree, where applicable.		
14	Proof of adoption where applicable.		
15	Legal separation order, where applicable.		
16	Proof of a union recognised in terms of the Recognition of Customary Marriages Act, 1998 (Act No. 120 of 1998), where applicable.		
17	Proof of payment of the applicable fee		
18	A yellow fever vaccination certificate if that person travelled or intends travelling from or transiting through a yellow fever endemic area: (Provided that the certificate shall not be required where that person travelled or intends travelling in direct transit through such area)		
19	the right to a pension or an irrevocable annuity or retirement account which will give such foreigner a prescribed minimum payment of R37 000 per month for the rest of his or her life from the country of his or her origin; or a minimum prescribed net worth R37 000 which may include a combination of assets realising per month.
